Our Electronic Funds Transfer Terms



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“Our Electronic Funds Transfer Terms” explains your and our rights and responsibilities concerning electronic fund transfer (EFT) debits from and credits to the accounts you have with us. EFTs are electronically initiated transfers of money involving an account with us and multiple access options, including Online Banking, direct deposits, automated teller machines (ATMs), Debit MasterCard (Card), and PAL (audio response system services).

1. EFT Services

a. Automated Teller Machines

You may use your Card and personal identification number (PIN) at Automated Teller Machines (ATMs) of the Credit Union, STAR, Plus, Co-op, Maestro, All Point, and MasterCard, and such other machines or facilities as we may designate. At the present time, you may use your Share Only ATM Card to:

- Withdraw cash from the savings account with us.
- Get balance information about the savings account with us.

At the present time, you may use your Debit MasterCard to:

- Deposit funds to the checking or savings accounts with us.
- Withdraw cash from the checking or savings accounts with us.
- Obtain balance information about the checking or savings accounts with us.
- You may use your overdraft options available to you (transfer from shares, transfer from Overdraft Protection Loan, or Overdraft Privilege, if opted-in), for debit card purchases and ATM withdrawals. However, your available balance will NOT include funds available through these overdraft options.

b. Direct Deposit

On the instruction of (i) your employer, (ii) the Treasury Department, or (iii) other financial institutions, we will accept direct deposits by EFT of your paycheck or of federal recurring payments, such as Social Security.

c. Preauthorized Debits

You may make direct withdrawals by EFT from the checking or regular savings account you have with us to a particular person or company, at least periodically, which you have arranged with that person or company, provided you have enough funds in the account with us to cover the payment.

d. PAL

If we approve your application for telephone access to the accounts you have with us under the PAL service, you may use a telephone to access the account with us and conduct EFTs by calling 731-664-1784 or toll-free at 1-800-227-1893. You must use your PIN along with your account number to access the accounts. At the present time you may use PAL to:

- Transfer funds from the savings, checking to savings, checking, line of credit, and internal third party accounts with us.
- Make payments from the savings, or checking to line of credit, or loans.
- Obtain balance information about the checking, savings, term share certificate, line of credit or Loans, and Club Accounts.
- Obtain withdrawal history about the checking, savings, term share certificate, line of credit or Loans, and Club Accounts.
- Obtain deposit history about the checking, savings, term share certificate, line of credit, and Club Accounts.
- Obtain transaction history about the checking, savings, term share certificate, line of credit or Loans, and Club Accounts.

e. Online Banking

If we approve your application for Online Banking, you may use a personal computer to access the accounts. For this service, you

will need a personal computer with internet access. The address for Online Banking is www.leaderscu.com. You may select a PIN. You must use your PIN along with your account number to access the accounts. You are responsible for the installation, maintenance, and operation of your computer and software. We will not be responsible for any errors or failures involving any telephone service, internet service provider, your software installation or your computer. At the present time, you may use Online Banking to:

- Transfer funds from the savings, checking, line of credit to savings, checking, line of credit, and loans with us.
- Make payments from the savings or checking to line of credit or loans.
- Obtain balance information about the checking, savings, term share certificate, line of credit, loans, or Club Accounts.
- Obtain withdrawal history about the checking, savings, term share certificate, line of credit, or Club Accounts.
- Obtain deposit history about the checking, savings, term share certificate, line of credit, or Club Accounts.
- Obtain transaction history about the checking, savings, term share certificate, line of credit, loans, or Club Accounts.
- Initiate A2A transfers.

Transactions involving the accounts you have with us are addressed by the BSA, whereas transactions involving a loan are addressed by the applicable loan agreement(s).

f. Bill Pay

You may use the Bill Pay service (accessed through Online Banking or Mobile Banking) to make payments to third parties. Use of the Bill Pay service requires enrollment in Online Banking and agreement to the Bill Pay service terms and conditions. You may use the Bill Pay service to:

- Make loan payments from any checking account to a loan account with us.
- Make payments from any checking account to another financial institution.
- Pay bills from any checking account with us.
- Transfer funds to other people using the account to account (A2A) transfer feature.

Please note that if payment to a payee is made by check, the check may be processed and debited from the account you have with us before the scheduled payment date.

g. Mobile Banking

Mobile Banking is a personal financial information management service that allows you to access account information, make payments to merchants who have previously consented to accept payments through Online Banking and make such other transactions as described in the Online Banking Service Agreement using compatible and supported mobile phones and wireless devices (“Wireless Device”). You agree and understand that the Mobile Banking service may not be accessible or may have limited utility over some mobile telephone networks, such as while roaming. When you register for Mobile Banking, the designated accounts and bill payment payees linked to the account through Online Banking will be accessible through Mobile Banking.

At the present time, you may use Mobile Banking to:

- Transfer funds from the savings, checking, line of credit to savings, checking, line of credit, and loans with us.
- Make payments from the savings or checking to line of credit or loans.
- Obtain balance information about the checking, savings, term share certificate, line of credit, loans, or Club Accounts.

- Obtain withdrawal history about the checking, savings, term share certificate, line of credit, or Club Accounts.
- Obtain deposit history about the checking, savings, term share certificate, line of credit, or Club Accounts.
- Obtain transaction history about the checking, savings, term share certificate, line of credit, loans, or Club Accounts.

For all mobile check deposits, you must endorse the original paper check with your name and write: "FOR LEADERS CREDIT UNION MOBILE DEPOSIT ONLY" in the endorsement area. If you fail to provide this endorsement, we may refuse the deposit and return it to you. You agree to indemnify the Credit Union from any liability or loss to the Credit Union arising from the payment of the original paper check without such required endorsement.

h. Debit MasterCard

You may use your Debit MasterCard to purchase goods and services any place MasterCard is honored by participating merchants and merchants accepting the Card and PIN at point of sale (POS) terminals. Funds to cover your Card purchases will be deducted from the checking account. If the balance in the account is not sufficient to pay the transaction amount, we may treat the transaction as an overdraft request pursuant to any overdraft protection plan, or we may terminate all services under the BSA.

i. Electronic Check Transaction

You may authorize a merchant or other payee to make a one-time electronic payment from the checking account using information from your check to pay for purchases, pay bills or pay other obligations ("Electronic Check Transactions"). You agree that your authorization for an electronic check transaction occurs when you initiate such a transaction after receiving any required notice regarding the merchant's right to process the transaction or payment, including any written sign provided by the merchant at the time of your transaction. All terms governing electronic funds transfer services will apply to Electronic Check Transactions. You remain responsible for notifying us of any unauthorized electronic check transaction shown on your statement.

j. A2A Service (Account to Account)

The A2A service enables you to request a transfer of funds: (1) from the account with us that is eligible to be used with and is enrolled in the service ("Eligible Credit Union Account") to your account at another financial institution enrolled in the service ("Verified Account") or (2) from a Verified Account to your Eligible Credit Union Account. We generally use the ACH Network to execute A2A transfer requests, but other methods of transfer may also be used. A2A transactions are subject to the special A2A terms and conditions set forth elsewhere in this Agreement.

2. Service Limitations

a. Automated Teller Machines

Withdrawals. Your Debit MasterCard is limited to 20 transactions a day, in any combination of ATM and point-of-purchase transactions, and you may withdraw up to \$600 (if there are sufficient funds in the account) in any one 24-hour period. For ATM only cards, you may only access your primary share account, and you may perform up to 5 ATM transactions (including withdrawals and inquiries) per day and withdraw up to \$600 (if there are sufficient funds in the account) in any one 24-hour period.

b. PAL

The accounts with us can be accessed under the PAL service via a touchtone telephone only. Not all push button phones are touchtone. Converters may be purchased for pulse and rotary dial phones. PAL will be available for your convenience seven (7) days a week. This service may be interrupted for a short time each day for data processing. If you call during this time, you will hear a message directing you to call back. We may limit the number of certain types of withdrawals from some accounts, as described in "Our Rates." No transfer or withdrawal may exceed the funds available in an account with us. We reserve the right to refuse any

transaction which would draw upon insufficient funds, exceed a credit limit, lower an account below a required balance or otherwise require us to increase our required reserve on the account.

c. Online Banking

1) Transfers. You may make funds transfers to the accounts with us, or other accounts you authorize, as often as you like. We may limit the number of certain types of withdrawals from some accounts, as described in "Our Rates." You may transfer or withdraw up to the available balance in the account or available credit line at the time of the transfer, except as limited under other agreements. We reserve the right to refuse any transaction that would draw upon insufficient or unavailable funds, lower an account below a required balance or otherwise require us to increase our required reserve on the account.

2) Account Information. Account balance and transaction history information may be limited to recent account information. The availability of funds for transfer or withdrawal may be limited, due to the processing time for ATM transactions. See "Funds Availability of Deposits."

3) Email and Stop Payment Requests. We may not immediately receive email communications that you send and we will not act based on email requests until we actually receive your message and have a reasonable opportunity to act. Any stop payment request you transmit electronically is deemed to be a verbal request and will expire in fourteen (14) days unless confirmed in writing as addressed in the BSA. Contact us immediately regarding an unauthorized transaction or stop payment request.

d. Mobile Banking

You are fully responsible for understanding how to use Mobile Banking before you actually do so, and you must use Mobile Banking in accordance with any use or operational instructions posted on our web site. You are also responsible for your use of your Wireless Device and the Mobile Banking Service software provided to you. If you authorize the use of biometric login (for example, fingerprint or retinal scan) for Mobile Banking, the service may be accessed using any biometric login recognized by your wireless device, even if it is not your own. If you have permitted another person to use their own biometrics to authorize activity on your wireless device, their biometrics will also gain access to Mobile Banking if you have authorized biometric login. We will not be liable to you for any losses caused by your failure to properly use Mobile Banking, the Software or your Wireless Device. You may experience technical or other difficulties related to Mobile Banking that may result in loss of data, personalization settings or other Mobile Banking interruptions. We assume no responsibility for the timeliness, deletion, misdelivery or failure to store any user data, communications or personalization settings in connection with your use of Mobile Banking. We assume no responsibility for the operation, security, or functionality of any Wireless Device or mobile network that you utilize to access Mobile Banking. Financial information shown on Mobile Banking reflects the most recent account information available through Mobile Banking, and may not be current. You agree that we are not liable for delays in updating account information accessed through Mobile Banking. We are not responsible for any actions you take based on information accessed through the Mobile Banking app that is not current. If you need the most current account information, you agree to contact us directly.

e. Debit MasterCard

Your Debit MasterCard is limited to 20 transactions in any one 24-hour period, in any combination of ATM and point-of-purchase transactions. MasterCard purchases are limited to the balance available in an account. We reserve the right to refuse any transaction that would draw upon insufficient funds or require us to increase our required reserve on the account. We may set other limits on the amount of any transaction, and you will be notified of those limits. You are solely responsible for any disputes you may have with merchandise or services received using the Debit MasterCard. We are

not responsible for any damages, liability or settlement resolution as a result of the misrepresentation of quality, price, or warranty of goods or services by a merchant.

The use of a Card and Account with us are subject to the following conditions:

1) Ownership of Cards. Any Card or other device that we supply to you is our property and must be immediately returned to us, or to any person whom we authorize to act as our agent, or to any person who is authorized to honor the Card, according to instructions. The Card may be repossessed at any time at our sole discretion without demand or notice. You cannot transfer the Card or Account to another person.

2) Honoring the Card. Neither we nor merchants authorized to honor the Card will be responsible for the failure or refusal to honor the Card or any other device we supply to you. If a merchant agrees to give you a refund or adjustment, you agree to accept a credit to the account with us in lieu of a cash refund. You may not use the Card for any illegal or unlawful transaction. We may refuse to authorize any transaction that we believe may be illegal or unlawful.

3) MasterCard Automatic Billing Updater. The account you have with us is automatically enrolled in the MasterCard Automatic Billing Updater Service (ABU). The service is provided as a benefit in order to facilitate uninterrupted processing of recurring charges you have authorized. Under the ABU service, if you have authorized a participating merchant to bill your Card for recurring payments, your new Card number and expiration date will automatically be sent to that merchant if we change your Card number (i.e. when replacing a lost or stolen Card). Card numbers are only supplied to merchants who participate in the ABU service. Because not all merchants participate in the ABU service, you should still notify each merchant when your Card number changes in order to permit recurring payments to continue to be charged to the account. You may opt out of the ABU service at any time by calling us at 731-664-1784 or toll-free at 800-227-1893 or by visiting us at one of our branches.

4) Currency Conversion; International Transaction Fee. Purchases and withdrawals made in foreign countries will be billed to you in U.S. dollars. The currency conversion rate for international transactions, as established by MasterCard International, Inc., is a rate selected by MasterCard from the range of rates available in wholesale currency markets for the applicable central processing date, which may vary from the rate MasterCard itself receives, or the government-mandated rate in effect for the applicable central processing date. In addition, you will be charged an International Transaction Fee as set forth in "Our Service Charges" for any card transaction at a location in a foreign country or with a merchant located in a foreign country even if you initiate the transaction from within the United States.

3. Security of Personal Identification Number

The Personal Identification Number (PIN) is established for your security purposes. The PIN is confidential and should not be disclosed to third parties or recorded. You are responsible for safekeeping your PIN. You agree not to disclose or otherwise make your PIN available to anyone not authorized to sign on the accounts with us. If you authorize anyone to have or use your PIN, that authority will continue until you specifically revoke such authority by notifying us. You understand that person may use the online account access, online services or debit card to review all of your account information and make account transactions. Therefore, we are entitled to act on transaction instructions received using your PIN and you agree that the use of your PIN will have the same effect as your signature in authorizing transactions.

If you authorize anyone to use your PIN in any manner, that authority will be considered unlimited in amount and manner until you specifically revoke such authority by notifying us and changing your PIN immediately. You are responsible for any transactions made by such persons until you notify us that transactions and access by

that person are no longer authorized and your PIN is changed. If you fail to maintain or change the security of these PINs and we suffer a loss, we may terminate your electronic fund transfer and account services immediately.

4. Member Liability

You are responsible for all transfers you authorize using your EFT services under this Agreement. If you permit other persons to use an EFT service, Card or PIN, you are responsible for any transactions they authorize or conduct on any of the accounts you have with us. However, tell us at once if you believe anyone has used the account, Card or PIN and accessed the accounts with us without your authority, or if you believe that an electronic fund transfer has been made without your permission using information from your check. Telephoning is the best way of keeping your possible losses down. For transactions using your Debit MasterCard, if you promptly notify us of your lost or stolen card, you will not be liable for any losses provided that you exercised reasonable care in safeguarding the Card against loss or theft.

5. Charges for EFT Services

There are certain charges for the EFT services as set forth on "Our Rates and Service Charges." We reserve the right to impose service charges at a future date after we give you notice of such changes as required by law. If you request a transfer or check withdrawal from your personal line of credit account, such transactions may be subject to service charges under the terms and conditions of your loan agreement. If you use an ATM that is not operated by us, you may be charged an ATM surcharge by the ATM operator or an ATM network utilized for such a transaction. The ATM surcharge will be debited from the account with us if you elect to complete the transaction.

6. Our Liability for Failure to Make Transactions

If we do not complete a transfer to or from an account with us on time or in the correct amount according to our agreement with you, we will be liable for your actual transaction loss or damage. Our sole responsibility for an error in a transfer will be to correct the error. You agree that neither we nor the service providers are responsible for any loss, property damage, or bodily injury, whether caused by the equipment, software, Credit Union, internet browsers internet access providers, online service providers or by an agent or subcontractor for any of the foregoing. Nor shall we or the service providers be responsible for any direct, indirect, special, or consequential economic or other damages arising in any way out of the installation, download, use, or maintenance of the equipment, software, online access services, or internet browser or access software. In this regard, although we have taken measures to provide security for communications from you to us via the online access service and may have referred to such communication as "secured," we cannot and do not provide any warranty or guarantee of such security. In states that do not allow the exclusion or limitation of such damages, our liability is limited to the extent permitted by applicable law. Our Credit Union will not be liable for the following:

- If, through no fault of ours, you do not have adequate funds in an account to complete a transaction, the account is terminated, or the transaction amount would exceed your credit limit on your line of credit.
- If you used the wrong identification code or you have not properly followed any applicable computer, Internet, or Credit Union instructions for making transfers.
- If your computer fails or malfunctions or if our Credit Union's online access system was not properly working and such problem should have been apparent when you attempted such transaction.
- If the ATM where you are making the transfer does not operate properly, does not have enough cash or you use your Card improperly.

- If circumstances beyond our control (such as fire, flood, telecommunication outages, postal strikes, equipment, or power failure) prevent making the transaction.
- If the account with us is frozen because of a delinquent loan or is subject to legal process or other claim.
- If the error was caused by a system beyond our Credit Union's control such as your Internet Service Provider, any computer virus, or problems related to software not provided by our Credit Union.
- If you have not given our Credit Union complete, correct, and current instructions so our Credit Union can make a transfer.
- If the error was caused by any applicable ATM or payment system network. The ATM machine may retain your Card in certain instances, in which event you may contact our Credit Union about its replacement.

We may establish other exceptions in addition to those listed above.

7. Termination of EFT Services

You agree that we may terminate this Agreement and your use of any EFT services, if you, or any authorized user of the account or PIN breach this agreement with us, or if we have reason to believe that there has been an unauthorized use of your Card, account or identification code.

You or any other party to the account can terminate this Agreement by notifying us in writing. Termination of service will be effective the first business day following receipt of your written notice. However, termination of this Agreement will not affect the rights and responsibilities of the parties under this agreement for transactions initiated before termination.

8. Notices

We reserve the right to change the terms and conditions upon which this service is offered.

9. ATM Safety Notice

The following information is a list of safety precautions regarding the use of Automated Teller Machine (ATM) and Night Deposit Facilities.

- Be aware of your surroundings, particularly at night.
- Consider having someone accompany you when the ATM or night deposit facility is used after dark.
- If another person is uncomfortably close to you at the time of your transaction, ask the person to step back before you complete your transaction.
- Refrain from displaying your cash at the ATM or night deposit facility. As soon as your transaction is completed, place your money in your purse or wallet. Count the cash later in the safety of your car or home.
- If you notice anything suspicious at the ATM or night deposit facility, consider using another ATM or night deposit facility or coming back later. If you are in the middle of a transaction and you notice something suspicious, cancel the transaction, take your card or deposit envelope, and leave.
- If you are followed after making a transaction, go to the nearest public area where people are located.
- Do not write your personal identification number or code on your card.
- Report all crimes to law enforcement officials immediately.

10. Special A2A Terms

You agree to use the Service for legal purposes and not in violation of any laws, including but not limited to, laws and regulation designed to prevent Money Laundering and laws prohibiting internet gambling. If any of the accounts has a joint account holder, you represent and warrant that the joint account holder has consented for you to represent both and use the account with this Service. If you do not give such consent, you should not use that account and we will terminate your use of Service if we are notified of such situation.

a. Authorization to Transfer Funds

You represent to us that you own each Eligible Credit Union Account, Verified Account and have full right and authority to all the funds on deposit therein. In addition, you authorize us to execute and charge your Eligible Credit Union Account(s) for any A2A transfer request to a Verified Account and from a Verified Account to your Eligible Credit Union Account, including any related fee, subject to any applicable limit as to dollar amount, time delays to complete transfers when your A2A transfer requests are made in accordance with the procedures established by us. You agree that we have no obligation to execute any request for a transfer using A2A transfer that is not initiated in accordance with such procedures. You understand that acceptance and processing of an A2A transfer request is subject to the terms and conditions stated in this Agreement, as amended from time to time. This authorization shall remain in full force and effect until you have informed us and we have had a reasonable opportunity to act on it. You agree that we are relying upon the information you provide in originating an A2A transfer on your behalf. Any errors in the information, including incorrect or inconsistent account names and numbers or the ABA number or name of the financial institution holding your Verified Account are your responsibility. You agree that if A2A transfer instructions identify a Verified Account by name and account number, the relevant financial institution may execute those instructions by reference to the account number only, even if such number does not correspond to the name. You understand that financial institutions holding your Verified Accounts may not investigate discrepancies between names and numbers and we have no responsibility to investigate discrepancies between names and account numbers. Not all types of accounts are available for funds transfer service. For example, retirement, business or corporate accounts. Also you must check with your financial institution to verify their ability to participate in external funds transfer service. Also, there may be limitations related to each transaction such as total amount, number of transactions allowed, or total transaction amounts defined by your financial institution. All funds transfers are also subject to the rules and regulations governing the relevant Verified Accounts. You agree not to request any A2A transfers from or to Verified Accounts that are not allowed under the rules or regulations applicable to such accounts.

b. Account Set-up and Verification

We will initiate a funds transfer request for you when you access your Eligible Credit Union Account(s) through the Home Banking service using the established login credentials. Our procedures are designed to authenticate your identity before accepting a request for an A2A transfer but not to detect errors in the content of your instructions. You authorize us to verify your account at another financial institution ("Third Party Account") through the use of a trial transfer, in which three low value transactions will be made between the accounts. Once the verification process is successful, each Third Party Account will become a Verified Account. You agree to verify online the amounts of such deposits and/or withdrawals. Upon your request, we will make electronic transfers from your designated and active Eligible and Verified Accounts via the Automated Clearing House (ACH) system in the amount you specify. You agree that such requests made with this Service constitute your written authorization for such transfers. You understand that your bank may limit the number of transactions that you authorize using your savings or money market account.

c. Transfer Requirements and Conditions

Your request for a transfer will be executed on the current business day so long as it is initiated by the cutoff time of 2:00 p.m. If your request for a Standard transfer is received by us on a day that is not a business day or on a business day after the established cut-off hour, we will not process your request until the next business day.

We may change your transfer limits at any time. Any decrease will be subject to notice, as required by law, but you agree that we may

reduce your limits or deny a transaction without prior notice upon occurrence of a Disqualifying Event, including: (i) any of your Credit Union accounts are not current or are not in good standing, (ii) you have had an overdraft, an over-limit item, or an item returned for insufficient funds with respect to any Credit Union account during the current or six (6) prior calendar months, or (iii) you have had any prior transfer to or from a non-Credit Union account canceled, revoked, or uncompleted due to insufficient funds, revoked authorization, stopped payments, frozen accounts, or any similar reason.

d. Modifying or Cancelling Pending Transfers

Pending transfer instructions can be cancelled or modified until the status changes to "In Process." Transfer Instructions cannot be cancelled or modified after cut-off time on the transfer date. If you close any of your Eligible or Verified Accounts, you are responsible to remove it from the Service to avoid any transaction failure and charges related to a failed transaction. There may be additional fees to you for failed transactions.

e. Rejection of an A2A transfer Request

We reserve the right to reject your funds transfer request. We may reject a request if the dollar value of one or more of your transfer requests exceed the daily or monthly transfer limit if you have insufficient available funds in your Eligible Credit Union Account for the amount of the A2A transfer, if your request is incomplete or unclear, if we identify a security risk related to a requested transfer or if we are unable to fulfill your request for any other reason. You understand that if we reject a request for an A2A transfer for one or more of the reasons set forth above, you will be informed of the rejection during your online session or by email as soon thereafter as we have determined to reject the request.

f. Cancellations, Amendments or Recalls

You may cancel or amend a funds transfer request only if we receive your request prior to the execution of the funds transfer request and at a time that provides us with a reasonable opportunity to act upon that request. We shall not be liable to you for any loss resulting from the failure of the beneficiary bank to agree to a recall or amendment of your funds transfer request. You further agree that we shall not be responsible for any delay, or failure to execute your funds transfer request due to circumstances beyond our reasonable control - including, without limitation, any inaccuracy, interruption, delay in transmission, or failure in the means of transmission of your funds transfer request to the bank or execution of such request by the bank, whether caused by strikes, power failures, equipment malfunctions, or acts or omissions of any intermediary bank or beneficiary bank.
